



## **Community Health Worker**

Coal Country Community Health Center has an opportunity for a full time Community Health Worker to work with our Home and Community Based Services. The Community Health Worker (CHW) is responsible for helping patients and their families navigate and access community services and other resources. The CHW support providers and the Medical Home team through an integrated approach to care management and community outreach by following the plan of care. As a priority, activities will promote, maintain, or improve the health of patients and their families. The CHW may provide social support and informal counseling and advocates for individuals and community health needs, providing services such as blood pressure screenings and the assessment of social risk factors.

This position requires written and oral fluency in English; good communication skills to include listening; ability and willingness to provide emotional support, encouragement, and motivation to patients; understand the community served with community connectedness; basic computer skills required, electronic medical record (EMR) experience preferred; experience working in a community-based setting for at least 1 to 2 years, preferred; Certified Nurse Assistant, preferred.
