The IMPACT Program School Nurse will identify barriers and provide such services as case finds, health education, referral, and direct patient care to prevent serious health problems and assist in managing current chronic conditions.

The IMPACT Program School Nurse will be qualified to practice as a Registered Nurse (RN) in the state of North Dakota and holds an unrestricted license. A minimum of 5 years' experience in public health, primary care, pediatric nursing, or urgent/emergency care, required.
